KIDS KINO INDUSTRY – SUBMISSIONS REGULATIONS

Who can submit a project?

Only producers can submit projects. By submitting the project the producer declares that he/she is the right-holder of the project and grants the organizer the right to publish information about the project, pictures and any other information submitted with the application (except the information used only for the process of selection), video presentation on the Kids Kino Industry website and in the catalogue (print or digital).

Producers must hold the rights to the project including:

- the right to present the project and any of its part to the public
- the right to publish information about the project and any of its parts in any form.

The producer may apply with a team of two people involved in the project e.g., producer + scriptwriter (together they will be named as Pitching Team). By applying with the project they declare that they will take part in a Pitching Training and attend

the forum in September/October to present the project and meet with our Decision Makers and Attendees of the forum.

Submissions

By submitting the project, the producer admits that he/she has read the regulations and agrees with them.

By submitting the project, the right-holders of the projects:

- grant to the organizers the right to use the headline picture (marked as Lead_name of the project) and other pictures attached to the submission form for the Kids Kino Industry promotional materials. The aim of using these materials is always the promotion of the event and the selected projects. The visuals will be accompanied by the title of the project.

Participation fees

The submission fee is free of charge.

Accreditation for the selected projects

Two accreditations including the cost of the Pitching training, accommodation (3 nights) and access to the whole events during the Kids Kino Industry forum will be given to the two members of the Pitching Team*. (Please note, that the accommodation part doesn't apply if the event is held online).

Any additional costs not listed above are not covered by the organizer.

*If the Pitching Team would like to consist of more than two members to be present at the forum, the cost of the accreditations for an extra members will be covered by them.

Pitching

Once the project is selected, the Pitching Teams are obligated to prepare and give the presentation of the project in front of our Decision Makers and attendees of the forum or prerecord the pitch which will be available on the Kids Kino Industry platform to be watched by our Decision Makers and accredited guests.

Before the event, it is obligatory for the Pitching Teams to take part in the Pitching Training. The Pitching Teams will receive more information on the date and pitching trainee individually.

In case the event is organized online, each Pitching Team will be asked to prerecord their pitching and send it to the organizers by the end of August.

Projects in development will have 5 minutes for the pitch + 5 minutes for Q&A with an audience; work in progress projects will have 8 minutes pitch + 5 minutes for Q&A with an audience; market presentation will have 5-10 minutes for the pitching + 5 for Q&A with Decision Makers, they will be also asked to prepare up to the 15 minutes presentation of the

audiovisual materials and footage which will be available during the event on the platform for our accredited guests and Decision Makers.

Confirmation of the participation

Producers whose project has been selected have time to confirm their participation in the forum till the end of July.

Selection process:

The Selection Committee will be announced before the 31 May. The Selection Committee will, among other things, take into consideration:

- creativity of the project
- original topic or format
- co-production potential

The project which won't meet the requirements will not be considered.

The decision taken by the Selection Committee is final and not subject to any reconsideration.

The project for Market Presentation will be selected by the organisers.

If any of the projects selected as the first ones withdraw from the forum, a title from the reserve list indicated by the Selection Committee may qualify for the event.
